



### **1. Does this apply at CPS?**

No. CPS students may have difficulty wearing masks the entire day. Our youngest eagles are welcome to wear masks but we will not be mandating it.

### **2. Will we still be notified if our child is in direct exposure to a positive individual?**

Yes. CSD is committed to notifying parents when their child has been in direct contact with a positive case. At that time you are welcome to quarantine your child irrespective of this policy.

### **3. What about the times when mask wearing isn't possible?**

There are certain occasions throughout the day (including, but not limited to, lunch, band, choir, and PE) where mask wearing is not feasible or appropriate. In these instances, existing established practices will be followed.

### **4. Does this mean no more quarantine?**

We anticipate that this will significantly reduce the number of individuals required to quarantine, however it will not eliminate it entirely. Quarantine is still required for direct exposure outside of school or in instances when mask wearing is not possible (such as at the lunch table).

### **5. Will teachers be required to wear masks when teaching?**

Face coverings should be worn by faculty and staff at all times when they are in close proximity to students or other staff members. In lecture formats, where the teacher is stationary and/or appropriately physically distanced from students, face coverings are not required.

### **6. My child is currently in quarantine. Does this apply retroactively?**

No. Prior to this policy change, we cannot verify that masks were being correctly worn by both parties at time of exposure. We look forward to welcoming many students back to school in the coming days.
