




CHS ALUMNI PUBLISHES

FROM GUITAR REPAIR TO A NATIONAL TOUR!

CHS Alum is on the road with Jeremy Camp WRITTEN BY WILL CONGER (CLASS OF 2017)

For the last several years, I have dived into guitar building and repair. I've worked for a vintage guitar shop, repaired hundreds of guitars, starting my own custom guitar building company, and now go on tour as the guitar tech for Jeremy Camp and his band!

Going on tour really came about in a crazy way. I have a friend who has been on tour with Jeremy for the last couple years as his photographer. I had always jokingly said that if they ever needed a guitar tech to throw my name out there. Well, out of the blue one day, he sent me a text asking if I could fill in for their tech for 10 days. I was blown away as I had never thought anything to come of my occasional joke. I accepted the offer and drove down to Nashville for the start of this previous fall tour. The experience was nothing short of incredible. I had no clue what to expect but was greeted by a team of people who love what they do, and love Christ more than anything.

We played 4 shows and at the end of that week I was offered to finish out the rest of the tour with them! I had about 6 hours to make a decision and get back to them. I really battled this decision as my wife is currently in EMT school and we have a one year old daughter. I was battling if it's okay or not for a husband and dad to just up and leave for work's sake. I was committing two months of my life with only a handful of times seeing them both. Two months may not seem like a lot, but it feels like it when you come home to a walking and talking baby girl. After some hard conversations in a very short time, we decided to take the opportunity. The things I was anxious about, Mal had peace. The things she was anxious about, I had peace. We knew that God wouldn't open this door not to have every other little thing covered and planned.

Touring was incredible, and it's not over for us. I was offered to become Jeremy's permanent guitar tech at the end of this fall tour. I am thoroughly enjoying my little over two months home with my girls until the winter jam tour in January.



I didn't expect to gain an entirely new family doing this. Touring is a very tight knit life. I couldn't do this if Jeremy and the band weren't genuine people. One of my first conversations with Jeremy was on how he has been doing this for over 20 years now and if a single show isn't for Christ and the desire to bring others to Him, he's done. We put on a phenomenal show and it is a ton of fun. Every bit of it is to worship Christ and to show others his redemptive love. This life will be a little different than normal for a little while but I am thrilled to be sent onto the American mission field every time that I get on that bus. I have story after story of gospel interactions with new faces across this country already. I'm so ready to keep going.

Be in constant prayer over my family and I as we are still learning this adjustment. Our desire is to be open handed to the Lord in everything.
